## **OLOA APPLICATION PROCESS FOR L2 RATING STATUS**

### **L2 OBJECTIVES AND QUALIFICATIONS**

1. Are we confident that this person can act as the R in all types of games?
2. Will the person serve as a positive mentor and role model to less experienced officials?
3. Does the person represent the upper echelon of officials in Oregon?
4. Does the person exhibit understanding of the rules & strong game management skills?
5. Does the person have the desire to continue to learn and improve?

### **APPLICATION CRITERIA**

1. Have at least 4 years of service in the OLOA
2. Have officiated a minimum of 80 OHSLA High School games.
3. Be a member in good standing of the OLOA and US Lacrosse at time of application.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

1. Written application (to include email) & a check for \$50 made payable to OLOA must be received by September 30<sup>th</sup> to be considered for the following season. Written application must be sent to Association Secretary and check sent to Association Treasurer.
2. Applications will be reviewed by November 30<sup>th</sup> to ensure that service and game minimums are met.
3. All qualifying applicants will be notified by Jan 15<sup>th</sup> as to their formal acceptance into the process.

### **EVALUATION PROCESS**

1. Take and pass L2 written test with a minimum score of 80%
2. Applicant will be observed and given at least two written evaluation. These evaluations shall be conducted during the first 4 weeks of the season. The applicant will be given a list of areas of improvement.
3. A third evaluation may be given to determine if applicant has improved
4. All current L2 officials will be asked for input on positive/negatives of the applicant.
5. The Evaluation committee will make the final decision on all applicants and issues written confirmation during the first week of September.

### **PAYMENT FOR EVALUATORS AND APPLICANTS**

1. Evaluators will be paid \$50 per observation.
2. Applicants granted L2 status will take effect (for pay purposes) the following season.
