### **OLOA APPLICATION PROCESS FOR 2010 HIGH SCHOOL SEASON**

#### **L2 OBJECTIVES AND QUALIFICATIONS**

- a) *Are we confident that this person can act as the R in all types of games?*
- b) *Will the person serve as a positive mentore & role model to less experienced officials?*
- c) *Does the person represent the upper echelon of officials in Oregon?*
- d) *Does the person have a good understanding of the rules & good game management skills?*
- e) *Does the person have the ability to continue to learn and elevate their game?*

#### **APPLICATION CRITERIA**

1. *Minimum of 4 years of service in the OLOA*
2. *Have officiated a minimum of 80 games; JV/Varsity (off season games do not count)*
3. *Be a member in good standing with US Lacrosse and OLOA at time of application.*

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

1. *Written application, to include \$50 check payable to OLOA, must be received by September 15<sup>th</sup> 2009. Send application & check to Dan Badders 14660 NW Bonneville Loop, Beaverton Oregon 97006*
2. *Application will be reviewed by November 30<sup>th</sup> 2009 to ensure game and tenure minimums have been met.*
3. *All qualifying applicants will be notified by Jan 15 2010 if they have been formally accepted into the process.*

#### **EVALUATION PROCESS**

1. *Take L2 written test and pass with a score of 80% or higher.*
2. *Applicant will be observed and given 2 written evaluations These evaluations will be made in the first 4 weeks of the season and the applicant will be given items for improvement. The applicant will given prior notifications of one of the two games observed.*
3. *A third evaluation will be made by mid season to observe if applicant has worked on and improved in prior noted evaluations.*
4. *All current L2 officials will be asked for input on positives/negatives of the applicant.*
5. *Evaluation committee will meet and review evaluations and L2 input and make final recommendation.*

#### **PAYMENT FOR EVALUATORS & APPLICANTS**

1. *Evaluators will be paid \$50 per observation*
2. *If an applicant is granted L2 status, for pay purposes it will take effect the following season.*
